All contestants must sign a waiver
releasing any liability against the Host Club
or T.S.W.G.A. **This waiver is on your
electronic registration and it must be
checked/signed.**

The field is limited to 144 players. Those
who have had their 50th birthday on or prior

to May 1, 2021, and who have a home course
handicap index of 30.4, or less, are eligible.
Entry fee for contestants is \$250.00. Guest
Fee is \$90.00 and should be paid as early as
possible.

Cancellations must reach the Advance
Registration Chairman by **Sunday, April 18th
for a full refund.** Cancellations after April 18th
will be refunded half the entry fee provided
there is an available replacement.

**Check-in will close at 2:00 p.m. Sunday,
May 9th. Contestants must report in
person by the close of check-in or they will
not be in the Tournament. No one may
check-in for another player. In the event of
car trouble or unavoidable delay, phone
the ARC at 248.229.9130 or the President at
281.770.1128 before 2:00 p.m.**

Qualifying for Championship Flight will be
limited to the low 32 handicap indexes, plus
ties when the field is set unless that number
changes due to cancellations. A play-off to
break ties will be held immediately after
qualifying to fill out the Championship Flight.

All other flights will be determined and
matched according to handicap indexes.
Those not qualifying will be paired for a
practice round on Monday. Match Play
begins on Tuesday. All play is governed by
USGA Rules of Golf.

Accommodations
