Timeouts...seems pretty simple correct? Is the timeout requested to be granted in the clip [here?](#)

We have a ball that blue 15 recovers and while into the air and before landing OOB, he requests a timeout. YES! Grant the timeout! If a player inbounds had asked for a timeout while jumping in the air and controlling the ball, we would grant it! In this clip, the player is STILL inbounds until he isn't! Until he touches OOB, he is still inbounds!

The NFHS rule for granting timeouts is different than for NCAA. This was a great 'hustle' and basketball IQ play!
