ORDINANCE NO. 19-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 27, OFFENSES, SECTION 2-9 SMOKELESS TOBACCO, OF THE NEWTON CITY CODE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County, Illinois, that CHAPTER 27, OFFENSES, SECTION 2-9 SMOKELESS TOBACCO, of the Newton City Code, be, and the same is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

27-2-9 SMOKELESS TOBACCO.

(A) **Definitions.** For the purpose of this article, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them:

Tobacco products: Any substance containing tobacco leaf, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco or dipping tobacco, nicotine gels and dissolvable nicotine products or any electronic smoking device.

Electronic smoking device: An electronic and/or battery-operated device, the use of which may resemble smoking, which can be used to deliver an inhaled dose of nicotine or other regulated substances. "Electronic smoking device" includes any such device, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed, or sold as an electronic cigarette, an electronic cigar, an electronic cigarillo, an electronic pipe, an electronic hookah, hookah pen, vape pens or any other product name or descriptor. An electronic smoking device excludes any product approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration as a nontobacco product used for medicinal purposes and is being marketed and sold solely for that approved purpose.

- **(B)** Sales to person under 21 prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to sell tobacco products or electronic smoking devices to any person under the age of 21 years.
- **(C)** Purchases by person under 21 prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to purchase tobacco products or electronic smoking devices, or to misrepresent their identity or age, or to use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing tobacco products or electronic smoking devices.
- **(D)** Possession by person under 21 prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to possess any tobacco products or electronic smoking devices, provided that the possession by a person under the age of 21 years under the direct supervision of the parent or guardian of such person in the privacy of the parent's or guardian's home shall not be prohibited.
- **(E) Use in City Park.** It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke tobacco products or use electronic smoking devices in the following areas of PETERSON and/or DuFRAIN Parks, in Newton, Illinois;
- 1. Within fifteen (15) feet of the Newton Aquatic Center, Putt Putt Course, Batting Cages and/or any public building or shelter, when those facilities are open for use by the public.
- 2. Within fifteen (15) feet of the skate park and any buildings and/or shelters at DuFRAIN Park.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any rule or regulation adopted or used pursuant thereto, or any provision of this Ordinance adopted herein by reference, shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$750.00, and the costs of prosecution and the attorney's fees of

the City in a minimum amount of \$175.00 per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
