DESCRIPTION: Beautiful high end target bow. Triple overlays on the back of the bow. Double-sided overlay tips. Overlays and tips are in great condition. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. There are two barely visible professionally filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic). No significant chips, dings or scrapes. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches, dings, and nicks here and there. There is a short crack in bottom of the overlay (see pic on p. 5. The sight window was tapped for a button. The decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

This bow sold for \$115 in 1967, which translates to \$890 in 2020 inflation adjusted dollars.
