

Pioneer Resident of Caseville Dies

Mrs. Ida Mae Richmond, 68 wife of James A. Richmond, died Thursday in her home southeast of Caseville after an illness of ten days.

Mrs. Richmond was born July 19, 1872, in Zilwaukee, Michigan. She came to Caseville township with her mother Mrs. Elizabeth Schubach and her grandparents Mr. and Mrs. Robert Morrison in 1880. She was a member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church and Caseville Chapter Order of The Eastern Star.
