## 70 applications received for e-manufacturing scheme

(Agency) New Delhi: The Government has received 70 applications for Rs 23,000-crore electronics component manufacturing scheme, and majority of applicants are small and medium enterprises, Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said. These applications have come within half a month of opening the window for the scheme. Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme has received tremendous response. Within 15 days of opening the application, around 70 applications have come, Vaishnaw said media. The Minister did not disclose the name of applicants.

However, sources have earlier mentioned that Tata Electronics, Dixon Technologies and Foxconn were among the big players that

have shown interest in the scheme.

Vaishnaw said that while some of the big players have applied, there has been huge interest in the scheme from small and me-



(Elcina), the country's oldest industry body of the Indian electronics sector, estimates that the demand-supply deficit for inputs in the electronics segment will increase to \$248 Billion to cater to projected \$500 Billion electronics production and it would be met largely by imports in absence of any measure from the government.

The major portion of the scheme, Rs 21,093 crore, is earmarked for sub-assemblies like camera module, multi-layered printed circuit board (PCB), flexible PCB, passive components that are fixed on the PCB by machines. A total of Rs 1,712 crore has been earmarked for making parts used in sub-assemblies and capital goods used in electronics manufacturing.

## FM calls for right balance of regulations, freedom

(Agency) New Delhi: Highlighting the importance of competitive markets, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday said the ability of CCI to strike a balance between regulatory vigilance and pro-growth mindset will be integral to building a resilient, equitable, and innovation-driven economic framework.

At the 16th Annual Day function of the Competition Commission of India (CCI), Sitharaman also said that there needs to have the right balance of regulations and freedom. CCI works to promote fair competition and prevent competitive practices in the marketplace. Besides, mergers and acquisitions beyond a certain threshold need approval of the watchdog.

The ability of the Com-

mission to strike a balance between regulatory vigilance with a pro-growth mindset will be integral to building a resil-

ient, equitable, and innovation-driven economic framework, the minister said, highlighting the efforts to become Viksit Bharat by 2047. The emergence of new technologies, Sitharaman,

who is also in charge of the Corporate Affairs Ministry, said artificial intelligence technologies raise novel questions about market power, transparency, data access, algorithmic biases, and the scope of competitive harm. Free and fair digital markets are challenged by the emergence of gatekeeper platforms, asymmetries in data access, and cross-border implications of digital business models. At the event, the minister also released the Diagnostic Toolkit for Public Procurement Officers as well as FAQs on combinations.



## S. Korea to spend \$349 million on developing AI-related services in 2025

Seoul, (IANS) South Korea will spend some 480 billion won (\$439.1 million) this year to develop innovative products and services based on artificial intelligence (AI), such as AI factories, AI chips and self-driving cars, the industry ministry said on Wednesday. The Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy said the investment is aimed at promoting the industrial use of AI to foster new growth engines and advance the

country's manufacturing industry, reports Yonhap news agency. In detail, the ministry will invest 62.7 billion won in developing AI factories, 21.6 billion won in AI chip technologies and 120.6 billion won in autonomous driving technologies. Some 68 billion won has been allocated for advanced bio projects, 29.6 billion won for intelligent robot development and 13.8 billion won for advancements in display technologies.

## iPhone exports from India to US surge 76 pc at 3 million units in April

New Delhi, (IANS) As Apple ramps up its India manufacturing plans, iPhone exports from the country to the US surged 76 per cent (year-on-year) in April, according to a new report. According to latest estimates by market research firm Omdia, nearly 3 million 'India-made' iPhones were shipped to the US in April. In comparison, iPhone shipments from China plummeted by a massive 76 per cent to just 900,000 units. This marks the first time India has consistently outpaced China in supplying iPhones to the American market, according to a report by CNBC, citing the data. "Apple has been preparing for this kind of trade disruption for years. The April spike likely reflects strategic stockpiling ahead of tariff hikes," Le Xuan Chiew, research manager at Omdia, was quoted as saying in the report. The demand in the US for iPhones is around 20 million per quarter at the moment.

## Bosch clocks 2 pc decline in Q4 net profit at Rs 554 crore

Mumbai, (IANS) Bosch Limited has reported a 2 per cent decline year-on-year (YoY) in its consolidated net profit for the fourth quarter ending March 31 (Q4 FY25), with profit after tax (PAT) standing at Rs 554 crore.

This is down from Rs 564 crore recorded in the same period last year (Q4 FY24), according to its stock exchange filing. For the full financial year FY25, Bosch reported a 19 per cent decline in consolidated net profit, which



dropped to Rs 2,013 crore from Rs 2,490 crore in FY24. However, the company saw a healthy rise in its revenue from operations, which increased to Rs 4,911 crore in Q4 from Rs 4,233 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous fiscal. The company's annual revenue showed strong growth, rising to Rs 18,087 crore from Rs 16,727 crore the

year before. Bosch also noted a rise in total expenses during the quarter, which grew by around 15 per cent YoY to Rs 4,369 crore from Rs 3,798.9 crore.

Bosch Managing Director Guruprasad Mudlapur said the company closed the financial year with robust revenue growth and improved sales across all business

segments, despite market challenges. "Amid a challenging business environment, we concluded FY24-25 with strong revenue growth and increased sales across businesses," Mudlapur stated. He added that India is set to become a major automotive hub, with increasing focus on digitalisation, electrification, and sustainable mobility. "In the coming years, we expect substantial growth in India as a strategic market, with an accelerated shift towards digitalisation, electrification and sustainable mobility," Mudlapur added. Looking ahead, Bosch is optimistic about growth in the Indian market. The board has recommended a final dividend of Rs 512 per equity share of Rs 10 each, pending shareholder approval.
