*Parents drive in Sylve Road or Thompson Road entrance; child’s name in windshield; all of the student’s labeled supplies are in a labeled bag/box; teacher will greet the student at the vehicle; staff members will take the bag/box and bring the supplies to the student’s classroom and place in desk and cubby.

August 19 2020-2021 School Term Begins
 (follow revised arrival and dismissal instructions)

Our “Meet and Greet” Drop-Off has been divided into two days—August 11th for lower elementary (Pre-K - 3rd grade) and August 12th for upper elementary (4th – 8th grade). This will produce less traffic and allow our staff and teachers to have easier access to/from our classrooms while maintaining social distancing guidelines. Teachers will be able to organize their students’ supplies and books in each of their classrooms, and sanitization guidelines will be followed. Parents will also receive a packet of important papers relevant to the start of school.

Additional guidelines change: The “fever-free (48 hours)” has been changed to “fever-free (72 hours) without fever-reducing medication before returning to school with medical approval.”

Our first day of regular school classes will begin on **August 19th**. CDC, LDH and state/federal guidelines will be followed in accordance with current updates. The health and safety of our faculty, staff, and Lake Castle families is our priority. Additional instructions and information will continue to be posted, along with answers to specific questions regarding the current guidelines and any changes that are required to be made. May everyone stay safe and healthy as we look forward to pursuing our “Excellence in Education” for the 2020-2021 school year!
