The key to many customs and traditions in Lent is what down through the ages has come to be known as Holy Week, the last week in Lent. It has becomes a tradition to trace the activities of Jesus that led to the cross of Calvary. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday as a reminder of

Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The people along the roadside waved palms and shouted "Hosanna" the Hebrew word for "save now." (See Matthew 21:1-11, Mark 11:1-10, Luke 19:28-40, and John 12:12-19.) Many churches today bless the palms and distribute them in the form of crosses to be worn by the worshipers.
