FINANCE- Ralph Flens reported that overall, we are in good shape. The Finance Committee is working on building up the funds for future projects.

LANDSCAPING – Chris Popp stated the committee members meet monthly and have some ideas of what plants will be needed to help beautify the entrances.

GARAGE SALE – Jay stated we will need a Volunteer to run the garage sale this year and to please let Ardsley Management know if you are willing to help.

ARC – Jay stated they have received several requests for review. These will be looked at, there are a lot of requests for new roofs. When making a request, ARC asks that you make sure to tell the vendor the color of shingles. If you are unsure of what color, please contact Ardsley Management. Also, please give Ardsley Management the name of the company

doing the work as they need to be licensed and bonded with the town of Schererville. After the work is completed, please take down the vendor signs.

Somr residents have had an issue with Surf Net when a sewer line was cut through. The resident is still dealing with Surf Net to resolve the issue.

Jay also indicated that Dish TV or any other company that uses the rooftop Dish must be put on the back side of the residence. We should also remind neighbors to notify ARC and put in a request when work or changes are needed or wanted at your residence.

Susan from Ardsley stated that we have 5 new owners, and 4 units are for sale at this time. There are 6 rental units, and all leases are on file with Ardsley.

MAINTEANCE COMMITTEE – Mark spoke about the Phase 2 driveways needing Black Ice to finish the few driveways that may have been missed. If you are one of the driveways that were missed, please contact Ardsley and they will notify the company. Black Ice will also be submitting a bid for some driveway repairs where there is standing water. The bid will be for small repairs. Mark also mentioned the potholes on Manistee and the town of Schererville needs to be called to address this.
