Immediately Following the Parade

Each Contestant must sign in with event coordinator prior to derby at starting ramp.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Condon and the Condon Chamber of Commerce located in Condon, Oregon all agents, servants and employees from any and all claims, causes of action and suits including but not limited to injury and loss of property caused by, arising out of or in any way connected with the participation in this Soap Box Derby.

I understand that participants are not covered by the State public liability or property damage insurance. Personal insurance coverage is at the prerogative of each individual contestant.

The Condon Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to alter the rules, events and conditions without personal notice of such change.

Rules of Competition

Hobby Class: Overall length of car shall not exceed 96 inches, including wheels and bodywork. Overall width of car shall not exceed four feet at any point. Maximum wheel diameter shall not exceed 12 inches. Maximum weight of car, excluding driver, shall not exceed 75 lbs.

Open Class: Any configuration. No restriction on size, weight or design (within reason).

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED TO RUN IN BOTH CLASSES. CARS WILL BE CLASSIFIED AT SIGN-UP AND A NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED TO DRIVER.

ALL CONTESTANS MUST WEAR HELMETS AND ALL CARS SHALL HAVE AN OPERABLE BRAKING DEVICE.

Scoring: Time permitting; all entries able to do so, will make two runs against the clock. A driver with a car trailer will be at the finish line to help racers return their cars to the starting ramp. After your run, keep clear of the course. Assemble at Announcer's Stand for presentation of awards after the derby.

Race will be conducted on Main Street and cars will start from a ramp, with the forward most point on car resting against a 12-inch high board.

SOAP BOX DERBY RULES

DIVISION I-HOBBY CLASS

- Length:** Overall length of car shall not exceed 96 inches, including wheels and bodywork. For ramp starting purposes, all hobby class cars shall be able to rest against a 12-inch high board at the forward most point on the car.
- Width:** Overall width of car shall not exceed four feet high at any point.
- Wheels:** Maximum wheel diameter shall not exceed 12 inches. Four wheels must be used, two front and two rear.
- Brakes:** All cars shall have an operable braking device.
- Weight:** Maximum weight of car, excluding driver, shall not exceed 75 lbs.
- Safety:** Helmets will be worn during competition.

DIVISION II-OPEN CLASS

Any configuration-no restrictions on size, weight or design.
Helmets must be worn during competition.
All cars shall have an operable braking device.

GENERAL RULES

- Entry:** All soap box racers shall register prior to race at the starting ramp. At this time, each car will be classified and each driver will receive his/her number to be worn while racing. Releases need to be signed by a parent/guardian.
- Class:** All entries will run either Hobby or Open Class. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED TO RUN IN BOTH CLASSES.
- Scoring:** Time permitting; all entries able to do so, will make two runs against the clock. A driver with a car trailer will be at finish line to help racers return their cars to the starting ramp. Keep clear of the course. After your second run, and your car is clear of the course, you will need to assemble at the announcer's stand for the presentation of awards.
