#### Prayer of the Day

**Dear Heavenly Father, Fill us today with Your unending love and mercy. As we enter this Lenten season, help us to see that Your Son endured the pain of the cross so that we can live as forgiven people. In Jesus' Name, Amen.**

**First Lesson Isaiah 14:10-20** [10](#) All of them will answer and say to you: 'You too have become as weak as we! You have become like us!' [11](#) Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, the sound of your harps; maggots are laid as a bed beneath you, and worms are your covers. [12](#) "How you are fallen from heaven, O Day Star, son of Dawn! How you are cut down to the ground, you who laid the nations low! [13](#) You said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; above the stars of God I will set my throne on high; I will sit on the mount of assembly in the far reaches of the north; [14](#) I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.' [15](#) But you are brought down to Sheol, to the far reaches of the pit. [16](#) Those who see you will stare at you and ponder over you: 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, who shook kingdoms, [17](#) who made the world like a desert and overthrew its cities, who did not let his prisoners go home?' [18](#) All the kings of the nations lie in glory, each in his own tomb; [19](#) but you are cast out, away from your grave, like a loathed branch, clothed with the slain, those pierced by the sword, who go down to the stones of the pit, like a dead body trampled underfoot. [20](#) You will not be joined with them in burial, because you have destroyed your land, you have slain your people. "May the offspring of evildoers nevermore be named!"

**Second Lesson Romans 10:8b-13** "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim); [9](#) because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. [10](#) For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. [11](#) For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame." [12](#) For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. [13](#) For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

**Gospel Luke 4:1-13** [1](#) And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness [2](#) for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing during those days. And when they were ended, he was hungry. [3](#) The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." [4](#) And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone.'" [5](#) And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. [6](#) and said to him, "To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. [7](#) If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours." [8](#) And Jesus answered him, "It is written, "'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'" [9](#) And he took him to Jerusalem and set him on the pinnacle of the temple and said to him, "If you are the

Son of God, throw yourself down from here, [10](#) for it is written, "He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you," [11](#) and "On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone." [12](#) And Jesus answered him, "It is said, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.'" [13](#) And when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from him until an opportune time.
