What is Jesus Project Ministries?

Jesus Project Ministries is an inner city ministry reaching the youth and poor of New Orleans. It also operates as a training center for believers who want to be better equipped to fulfill their destiny in God. Community Outreaches, servant-hood evangelism, mission trips and many other hands-on ministries are part of this training.

What does it mean to be a JPM Summer Intern?

Every summer Jesus Project Ministries serves as a ministry site to hundreds of volunteers through mission teams from throughout the country. Each summer college-aged young adults serve as Summer Interns. They help as we serve incoming teams to understand the heart of God for the youth and the poor as we serve our community through various outreaches such as Summer Bible Camp, Evangelism, Prayer Walks, Food Ministry, Senior Citizen Ministry, Homeless Ministry, the Arts and Service Projects . As a Summer Intern, you will have an opportunity to minister not only to those on the mission teams, but also those who live in our city. You will also participate in a community environment with other Summer Interns during times of prayer, worship and ministry.

What are the requirements for serving as a JPM Intern?

- At least 18 years old, and must have been out of high school for at least one year by the first day of internship (completion of one year of college is preferred, but not necessary)
- Must profess a Christian faith as a follower of Jesus Christ
- Must have a willingness to share the message of the gospel of Jesus with others
- Have a desire to serve in a missions-oriented environment
- Strong work ethic, integrity and the ability to work well with others from different denominations
- Willingness to serve in a position of leadership
- Willingness to be flexible
- Fundraising (The summer internship in NOT a paid position. You must raise funds as needed.)

What is the summer intern schedule?

- must attend Internship Training to be held April 21-23 (location TBD)
- must arrive Sunday May 28, 2017 (no later than 5pm) and will depart no earlier than Wednesday August 9, 2017
