An Ordinance consenting that Liquor Retailer's permit may be issued to premises within the town of Chesdale, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Board of Trustees of the town of Chesdale Indiana, that the consent of said town be and the same is hereby given and granted unto the proper legal authorities of the State of Indiana, to issue liquor retailer's permits for the sale of alcoholic, spirituous beverages to applicants otherwise duly qualified to premises within said town, all agreeable to the provisions of section eighteen (18) of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, entitled "AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages, liquors and substances, and to promote temperance, repealing laws and parts of laws and declaring an emergency," approved March 11, 1973.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
