

# HAROLD L. BURKE, DDS

## 1906-1994

Dr. Harold L. Burke, 88, longtime retired Sebewaing dentist, died Saturday morning, Oct. 22, in Dunedin, FL.

He was born in Canada on Feb. 26, 1906. He and Marie Ellen Zimmerman were married on Aug. 16, 1929. The Burkes moved to Sebewaing where he opened his practice. They resided in the upstairs apartment of the Arthur Martini residence, which was formerly the Hurdalbank Photo Studio. Later they built their home on Sixth Street and then on Beach Drive, east of Sebewaing. Doctor Burke began his dental practice in the upstairs of the former Eisengruber Cafe, which was Flowers by the Bay until several years ago. Doctor Burke then moved his practice upstairs over what is now Sebewaing Travel Agency.

After wintering several years in Arizona and Florida, Doctor Burke retired in the autumn of 1967. His practice was taken over by Dr. Dalton Coe in 1968, and the Burkes moved to Dunedin in 1972.

Mrs. Burke died in Dunedin on Oct. 28, 1993.

Dr. Burke is survived by two sons and daughters-in-law, Dr. James (and Betty) Burke of Colorado and Dr. Joseph (and Nancy) Burke of Hilton Head, SC, and one daughter and son-in-law, Sheila and Donald Villeneuve of Hudson, OH, eight grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral service information was not available at press time.
