Businesses must provide:

- A business plan;
- An estimate of the length of their stay;
- Specific accommodations required;
- Proof of general business liability insurance;
- A plan for costs related to phone, internet and electrical usage.

Business owners also should make contact with the Indiana Small Business Development Center (ISBDC).

Currently, StoneGate is home to nine business incubators and three non-profits.

Karen Pence, Second Lady of the United States, and former Indiana First Lady, was keynote speaker.

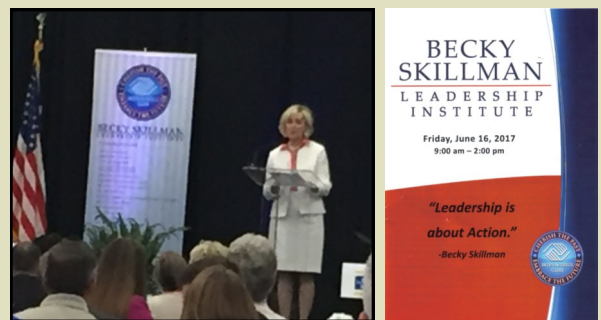
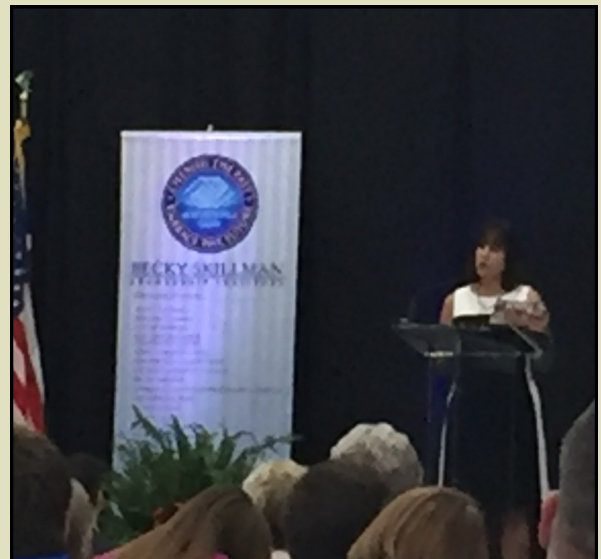
An award-winning water-color artist and former teacher, Pence's primary focus as Second Lady is to raise awareness of and to educate the public about the mental health profession of art therapy in the U.S. and around the world.

Other featured speakers included Maj. Gen. Courtney P. Carr, Adjutant General of Indiana; Kurt Godlevski, Butler Women's Basketball Head Coach; Tom Allen, Indiana University Football Head Coach; and Nashville-based country singer-songwriter Clayton Anderson, from Bedford.

A Lawrence County native, Becky Skillman initiated and mentors the annual event. She currently serves as Chair of the Board for Radius Indiana, an eight-county economic development corporation in South Central Indiana.

Skillman is a former Indiana State Senator, Majority Caucus Chair and Indiana Lieutenant Governor.

In her remarks, Skillman explained the purpose of the series is to engage and challenge attendees to expand their leadership skills and strategies. It began
