

Assistive Technology & the NDIS

Getting Started

The NDIS (National Disability Insurance Scheme) can fund a range of assistive technology (AT) that you can use to help you throughout your daily life.

This might include:

1. Equipment that can help with your mobility (e.g. a wheelchair or mobility scooter)



2. Equipment that can help with your transfers (e.g. a height adjustable bed or electric lift chair)



Step 1

- Appointment at your home with an Occupational Therapist (OT)
- OT and you will identify potential assistance technology (AT)

Step 2

- Equipment trial to make sure the AT is right for you. At home or showroom

Step 3

- NDIS Form completed by OT. You will need to sign the consent section of this form. The OT will help you with this.
- OT will send the AT request to the NDIS.

Step 4

- NDIS receives our AT request and considers whether they will approve the purchase.

Step 5

- If the purchase is approved by the NDIS, the AT will be delivered to your home. Please contact us if you require training in how to use it.
