TOWN OF PREECEVILLE

BYLAW NO. 8-2016

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Preeceville, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1) For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Preeceville; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the Town of Preeceville.
- 2) Council hereby appoints PRY Investigation and Security Agency of Rama, Saskatchewan, as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer of the Municipality.
- 3) The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the Council of the Municipality;
 - b) To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c) Other related duties as may be assigned by Council or its delegate.
- 4) That the Town of Preeceville is hereby authorized to enter into a contract, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as Exhibit"A" with PRY Investigation and Security of Rama, Saskatchewan for the purpose of bylaw enforcement as stated in the agreement.
- 5) The Mayor and the Administrator of the Town of Preeceville are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit "A".
- 6) This bylaw shall come into force upon the date of its final passing thereof.
