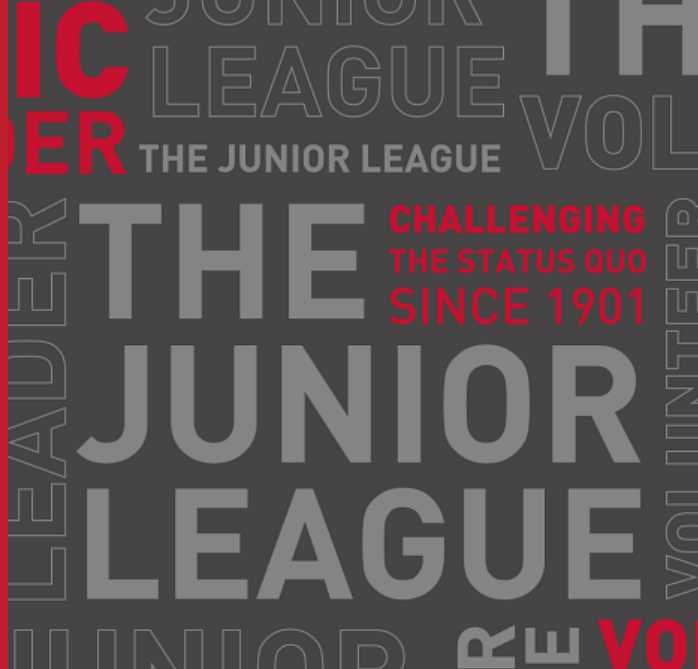
The Junior League of Napa-Sonoma is proud to support numerous community organizations in Sonoma and Napa Counties. Below is a list of some of the organizations & programs we support:
