Remote Learning Plan for Regional Alternative Programs (RAP), Elizabeth and Freeport sites for Regional Office of Education #8

- **Provides instruction to ALL students that reflect State Standards**

- The RSSP coordinator and RAP teachers have offered and provided devices to their students without a device. All students have been contacted and responded to any needs regarding technology.
- All students have access to an electronic device to access Edgenuity, the online curriculum platform, grounded in state standards

- **Allows the students to confer with educators**

- Students and families have access each school day to RAP teachers, paraprofessionals, and RSSP coordinator via text, email, and through the Edgenuity online communication. A letter was sent home with connect information and teachers have contacted each student and family.

- **Address needs of vulnerable populations, homeless students, and IEP students.**

- Our home districts are providing meals for those in need
- Our homeless coordinator and her staff are reaching out to those on their caseloads and have resources for our homeless population

- **Transition back to onsite learning**

- Staff and students will transition back to the classroom when the Governor deems it safe to do so.
- Students will continue their Edgenuity courses in the classroom and resume small group activity

Teacher/Para Expectations

- Staff must be available by email, Edgenuity, or teacher cell number throughout the school day, 8am to 1pm
- Classroom teacher ensures a minimum number of assignments are unlocked at the start of each day to permit progress, please make sure each student knows their daily goal
- Classroom teacher will have daily contacts with all students (Edgenuity, email, or cell), to check in and discuss progress
- All teacher attempts and actual contacts with students and parents must be documented. Teacher will share cumulative documentation with RSSP coordinator at the end of each school day
- Paraprofessionals will check in on Edgenuity daily to encourage students via Edgenuity messaging and check progress, and communicate anything necessary with classroom teacher

Student Expectations

- Log into Edgenuity every weekday
- Review Edgenuity goals that your teacher set up for you and work towards those goals daily
- Complete activities daily from multiple classes - all lessons cannot be in 1 class unless given permission by your teacher
- Have ability to communicate daily with teacher by email, Edgenuity, or teacher cell number regarding any questions or issues you might be having
