

#### Westy Wash Days News – October 2025

It's our birthday!! The first Westy Wash Day was in October 2024, and I think I can honestly say this project has become a success. The Westminster City Parks and Rec Department Homeless Navigators are putting the word out when we are offering our services, and they are also supplying fresh fruit and water for our participants. The August Wash Days served one hundred people between the two sites. This is excellent news except for one tiny little thing. We may be running short of resources before the end of the Elks year when I can once more apply for the grants in March. I was budgeting for \$600 to \$800 per month for laundry. Well, now we are spending about \$900 every month. In addition to the laundry services, we are spending about \$5 on hygiene products and \$7.50 on two pair of winter socks for each adult. I am sending along a photo of the things we're putting in the hygiene kits; a bottle of shampoo from Dollar Tree (\$1.25), a bar of soap and toothbrush from Costco (\$1.50) and a 5 oz. tube of toothpaste from Amazon (\$16.84 per 4 pack). Clearly, the grants we currently have won't make it through the winter at the rate we're going. So this is when I must ask for the support of the Westminster Elks to chip in and share what we can. If you are able to drop off a few items at the lodge, there is a laundry basket in the lobby for this purpose. If you would like to donate cash directly to the project send a check along to the lodge designating the Westy Wash Day account for deposit. And if you would like to come by the laundromats when we are there, please feel free to drop by and lend a hand at handing out the goods! As a reminder, the Hidden Lake Laundromat is at 5055 West 72nd Avenue (Sheridan and 72nd). We are there on Thursday Wash Days, and the Plaza Coin Laundry is at 7243 Federal



Blvd. where we are on our Saturday dates. We hope to see you there!

Upcoming Wash Days will be October 23 and 25. November 20 and 22, December 18 and 20, January 22 and 24, February 19 and 21, and March 19 and 21.

Again, Happy Birthday to us! And certainly not least, I want to extend many thanks to those who have helped with this project in gifts of time, money, food, water, and caring gifts of hygiene products. The laundry basket in the lodge lobby is the drop off point for any donation, and I am happy to shop for you if that is needed.
