Dear friends,

Now that we've reached the end of May, most of our regular programming has wound up for the summer. Confirmation, JAM education, even Wednesday afternoon Bible study have taken a break for the summer.

Since there isn't a lot going on right now, I'm going to use this space to remind you of some of the basic practices of congregational life. The first is, of course, participation.

Sometimes dinner gets ruined by something going wrong. One ingredient missing, one loss of attention, or one mistaken measurement can spoil the whole thing. There was one recipe I tried that I either read it wrong or it had a typo. I put in way too much basil. Kristen and I tried so hard to choke that down, but I still to this day can't stand the taste of basil!

Not that it matters to this story. The point of the story is that worship services are like dinner – each one is created with love and for the benefit of those who come together. Every dinner is designed to feed you. The same is true of our worship services. Each one is designed to benefit you, to give us all a time and space to celebrate God and everything that God has done for us. We do our best, but sometimes it's just not your favorite or to your taste. And sometimes there are so many other things going on that you have to skip one, even though we know it's bad for our health. Regardless, we hope you join us as often as you can.

After worship, we always sit down for coffee and treats. You don't have to bring anything, just yourself to gather and chat for a while. But you are invited to bring a snack to share, especially on the last Sunday of every month when we intentionally potluck our fellowship time.


