9-Pin No-Tap RULES

1. *Mixed Doubles 9-pin NO TAP is not a USBC certified event. One male and one female must be on each team.*
2. *Entry deadline is February 29, 2020, 1:00 pm. If tournament is full before that date, entries will be put on a waiting list in the order they were received.*
3. *Teams may enter tournament as many times as they wish. No team can cash more than once.*
4. *Persons unmarried and under the age of 18 must have written consent of parent or guardian.*
5. *HANDICAP - All bowlers receive 80% of the difference between their average and 220. Bowlers over 220 will receive zero. Men without a sanctioned average will be given a 170, women a 150. Failure to use a correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap, shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower. Bowlers have 48 hours from their date of competition to submit a corrected average. **Averages considered shall include sanctioned and non-sanctioned leagues.***
6. **For handicapping purposes only, the highest Yearbook of twenty-one (21) game average FROM LAST YEAR or back 3 years.** *If this year's average, as of December 31, 2019, is fifteen (15) pins higher, the higher will be used. Entrants without a Yearbook average for the past 3 years but with a current USBC average or any average from an unsanctioned league of twenty-one (21) games or more as of January 31, 2020 the present average will be accepted. Averages from summer leagues will be accepted if no current league average is established. Actual scores bowled will be used to calculate team totals. If a person has ever averaged more than 200 and has not bowled in more than 3 years, he or she will enter this tournament with a 210 average and handicap of 8 pins per game. The tournament reserves the right to assign a higher average to any bowler based on knowledge and experience of the specific bowler. This rerate or assigning of an average shall take place prior to completion of the first game of the series. Any bowler is entitled to a full refund if that bowler does not accept these average conditions.*
7. *Bowlers are subject to re-rating after 3 games of prior participation.*
8. *It is understood that openings in this event depend upon entries in the team events scheduled on these same dates. No paid entries can be bumped without the permission of the doubles team involved.*
9. *You may bowl with as many opposite sex bowling partners as you care to on the same squad as long as both pay the entry fee of additional \$ 10.00 per bowler before the completion of the 2nd frame of the 1st game.*
