Opening Prayer

Introduction to the readings

In the first reading, the prophet Ezekiel sees the exile of the chosen people in Babylon as a sort of death and their return home as a resurrection and spiritual renewal.

St Paul tells his Roman converts that 'just as it was the Spirit who raised Jesus to life now that same Spirit lives in us too.

In the Gospel of John, by raising Lazarus from the dead, Jesus shows us that he is the Lord of Life and death.
