Every State/Country to have a contest for new music to enjoy this special day. There will be 12 prizes and all these participants will get music contracts to help them develop their musical talents and to make more music. The songs will be played and everyone will dance to the music at stadiums in their communities.

The stadiums must be renovated and have cover if the weather becomes too hot or rainy. A variety of food and drinks must be available, including cooked meal, and comfortable areas to sit and eat. While watching the parades. Toilets/rest rooms must be adequate for the number of spectators and participants with the right toiletry available.

There will be colorful street floats, decorated street parades, and street band parades to enjoy the event. The parades and floats will end in the stadium, and every group will make a presentation in the stadiums and then retire. Every float and parade participant get a prize and a certificate for their participation. Prizes and certificates are to be given right before the end, and a kaleidoscope of musical ending.

The Harmony Associates are to work to keep the street parades and the stadium presentations moving smoothly and to protect the participants and the spectators at all times and at all events.

- IV. PAULETTIC PAJE ONE YEAR JOYFULBAND DAY. This is one week of joyfulness from June 29 to June 36 (2018), with Decorated streets, Decorated Stores, and Decorated Malls. The JOYFULBAND DAY is a day of Street Parades with instrument bands, drummer bands, children bands, girl bands, boy bands, school bands, college bands, community bands, and bands that tells the PAULETTIC PAJE story with beautiful decorated designs and refreshing and lively music. The bands end with presentations at stadiums and Arenas. Also, lots of music, gyrations (dancing), merriment, and a variety of different foods at the events. Onlookers can dance to the music and enjoy the merriment. Every band parade participant gets a prize and a certificate for their participation. Controlled fireworks display. Prizes and certificates are to be given right before the end. Must have kaleidoscope of musical ending. The Harmony Associates are to work to keep the street parades, stadiums and Arenas presentations moving smoothly and to protect the participants and the spectators. Street dancing in the evening going to the night is also allowed.
- V. All fireworks display for this event and other events must be in a controlled environment that is supervised, and approved. No open personal or individual fireworks in backyards, streets, open lots, rivers, lakes, pools; that is mal practice/illegal. If fireworks cannot be in the controlled environments alone, then no fireworks at all.
- VI. Wine and Cheese festival is a Public Century Tung Occassung for the lengthen season from March through April. It is a one-day event on March 18. The wine and cheese festival should be held no more than three times per year, as it is the festival for the communion. When we commune, we talk, and we share with each other. You should have bazaars with an array of fruits, vegetables, and good silver fish to eat. You should also have wine, beer, rum, and other alcohol to taste with a mixture of strong ucalyptus juice added to the alcohol. You can also have arts, crafts, books, music, etc., at the bazaars. You could also have funny communication

methods as well, to create good laughter. No meat eating at **this** lengthen festival. Meat can be eaten at the other wine and cheese festivals held at other times during the year. Century is an event for a time occasyung/occasion. A Tung is spoken words from the mouth with the tongue.

- VII. The Eastern Holy Day/Good Friday and the Torah Passover Day are close in timing and should not overlap each other. They are separate. The Torah Passover can begin after the Wednesday following Easter Monday.
- VIII. For the Eastern Holy Days, from Holy Thursday through Good Friday, no eating of meat. This is the time and the preparation of the death of one of me. She was burned, whipped, pierced, and tortured and put on a cross. The good stories you have read or heard about in the New Testament about the “thief Jesus” in the Bible and other books, it is about her/me. She is one of the Christ. In the Bible, she is called Paul.
- IX. Many versions of me have been in this Earth from time to time and have been killed in many different countries as the Federal governments, Republics, and Monarchy use Covoyance, terror, and torture on them and kept it quiet. The Jamaica government is controlled by America federal government, and so these bad events are planned by the Americans and Republics.
- X. The Torah Passover Day is in April. The Torah Passover Rememberance is for only two public days of memory. It is the first day and the second day. No more of the 7 days or 8 days Jewish holidays. Kosha foods are allowed to be eaten during this celebration for those who want to.
- XI. All Israel Torah nation eat regular meals throughout the rest of the year and no more Kosha foods.
- XII. Jewish holidays will be “observed”. Only Passover will be a public holiday of rememberance.
- XIII. Observed is to be marked on the calendar.
- XIV. No more Ramadon, fasting, pilgrimage. Islam & Arab holidays will be observed.
- XV. Chinese holidays will be observed.
- XVI. All Independence days festivity ends September 30, 2017. After this date, there will no longer be any independence festivity.
- XVII. All States or Countries in this Earth will no longer have their usual public holidays. The holidays will be observed by each State/Country only. The Centuria otherwise called a calendar below is the replacement.
- XVIII. May Pole Day (2018) Set up the colorful ribbon pole tents in Public parks, play a variety of different music and dance with the colorful ribbon pole (men and women). When you are put to dance, you have to dance to the music playing any way you want, without letting go of the ribbon. If you let go of the ribbon accidentally or not, you are out and another person steps in. For some music, you wine and go down and wine and go up.

The flute players get to present their flute music and participants dance to the flute music any way they want at the May Pole Parade. The Fluters play upbeat and joyful music for this occasyun. The Fluters also get prizes for their flute musical presentations.

The fluters will dress for the occasyung but not to wear bright colors to distract from their musical presentation. The Fluters are to know their music before this day and practice their musical presentations. The Fluters will be qualified on the musical presentations for this day and they will get prizes prior for their presentations and selected for this event. They say old flute that are good plays better music than new flute. All Fluters get a prize for their prior presentations and the top 12 to 15 are qualified and used for this event as some places their day is longer. Each Flute presentation should not be long. Each person should last about .25 of a centi, or 15 seconds, or between 3 to 5 minutes. A centi is six thousand (6,000) of a second. Centi is a centigram or a centimeter and is identified by using the word "centi".

Each ribbon pole tent is colorfully designed and set up differently. There are prizes for the designs and the colors. Every person gets a prize for their design and colorful ribbons (prizes 1 to 12 are the highest). When you go in and you dance to the music fully without letting go, at the end you get a prize. Children maypole for different age groups must also be set up.

The music to dance to, is a combination of old music or from about 1940's to the current year. Free practice for May pole dancing must be advertised on the TVs, Radios and Newspapers locally, so the communities can get to attend and learn how to dance and become comfortable with maypole dancing and music. Maypole Day is a beautiful and colorful festival day filled with laughter, harmony, and goodness. March and April are the early months for the free Maypole dance practice in the communities.

On May Pole Day, A Bazaar is set up with many booth owners selling many different items. The items include outdoor cooking, lots of different foods and cakes and tarts, drink and juices and punches. Selling items like books, arts, crafts, and much more.

- XIX. Crab eating day to share with friends and family. Having access to a variety of different crabs to buy. This involves outdoor cooking, indoor cooking, park cooking, boiled corn, roast corn, corn soups, dominoes playing. Roast potatoes, baked potatoes, roasted yams (yellow yam, white yam, purple yam, yampy yam, and so on) also use sweet potatoes. Playing music is also good for this event.
- XX. Sense Melia Day. Enjoy with family and friends sense melia cakes, sense melia drink with sugar and blend with fruits or vegetables. Sense melia rum punch, Sense melia and rice cakes and more things you can do. The sense Melia juice is used to make these tarts and drink. Dried fruits or preserved fruits can be used in the sense melia cakes or tarts as well.
- XXI. Fidel Castro Day, enjoyment of Cuban music and dances. Cuban foods, drinks, Cuban arts & crafts, BAZAARS, Cuban festival of music. And much more for the communities and States to do.
- XXII. Harvest day, no turkey, horse, sheep, lamb, deer, meals. Use Pork, Chicken, Fish, Beef, Vegetables, fruits, tarts, cakes, Pastas, Lasagnas, and so on. A family, friends and invited guests festivity.
- XXIII. A SheHero is a person who has gone over and beyond the normal to help others.

XXIV. No Santa Claus, No St. Nicholas, No Rudolph Reindeer, No Salvation Army ringing bells, No pan handling, No Santa Cruses, No Jesus in a manger, no manger scenes, No Mary & Joseph, No lying stories of Jesus birth in December or anytime to come. No reindeer scenes.

XXV. Below are the Joyful Days, Holy Days, Rememberance Days and they are all Public Days on the calendar to begin October 15, 2017, for this Earth and these Earths. November 1, 2017 becomes November 1, 2018. The New Year begins on November 1, 2018.
