





Greetings from Estes Park, Colorado, a sunny mountain town at the entrance to Rocky Mountain National Park. Explore the 415 square miles of this spectacular wonderland, and be sure to save time to enjoy charming downtown Estes Park and its many shops, restaurants and festivities. Music, parades, art shows, even rodeos make their way to this community, which means there's always something to do and WorldMark Estes Park puts you at the heart of all of it!

The resort consists of 64 studio, one-, two- and three-bedroom units and three-bedroom presidential units. Studio, one- and some two-bedroom units have a compact kitchen with a two burner stove, mini refrigerator, microwave and coffee maker. Most two-bedroom, all three-bedroom and presidential units have a fully equipped kitchen. Studios and one-bedroom units do not have a washer and dryer, but complimentary laundry facilities are available onsite. ResortNet 2, WorldMark's wireless Internet service, is available in all units for a small fee.

WorldMark Estes Park is happy to provide a seasonal outdoor pool (open April – October), three outdoor hot tubs, a fitness center and picnic area. Please note that parking is limited and we are unable to accommodate RVs and trailers.

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## On the Way to Estes Park

**Denver**, Colorado, is perfect for outdoor recreation--it's dry and sunny most days with temperatures dropping to an average of just 45 degrees in winter and reaching an average of 73 in the summer. Golf courses are open year-round, and the city's 200 parks offer plenty of green spaces to relax and enjoy yourself. **The Denver Zoo** covers 80 acres in City Park and attracts almost two million visitors per year. There are more than 4,000 animals representing 750 species. Spend some time with polar bears, sea lions and Komodo dragons. The **Coors Brewery** at 13th Avenue and Ford Street in Golden, Colorado provides tours and samples Monday - Saturday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. The brewery was opened in 1873 by a 26-year-old named Adolph Coors; today it is the nation's third largest single brewing site in the world.

Also in downtown, you'll find **Six Flags Elitch Gardens Theme Park**. Open between April and October, this theme park includes both an amusement park with roller coaster rides and a water park. If you're after the urban shopping experience, Denver is your place. The **16th Street Mall** is a tree-lined, milelong pedestrian promenade of red and gray granite that runs through the center of downtown. Enjoy outdoor cafes, renovated historic buildings, glass-walled skyscrapers, shops, restaurants and department stores. Numerous fountains and plazas offer daily special events and entertainment. While you're in the shopping mood, the historic **Larimer Square** adds a touch of frontier history to modern merchandising. Just a block from the 16th Street Mall and two minutes from Coors Field, this collection of stores and restaurants is as eclectic and upscale as the Mile-High City itself.

*Drive west on US 36...*

**Boulder** is home to Colorado's state university, nicknamed the Buffaloes. Founded in 1876, the campus has remained in one place, growing from a single building now called "Old Main" to its current 786 acres. The Flatirons--a series of uplifts in the foothills of Boulder--provide a stunning backdrop to one of the most beautiful college campuses in the nation. Downtown Boulder boasts an extensive collection of restaurants, ranging from casual brewpubs to fine French cuisine, and pedestrian-friendly shopping along **Pearl Street**. Meander for a while, duck into a gallery or two and then enjoy a leisurely meal of Creole, Nepalese, Caribbean, Asian or whatever else you're in the mood for. The scenic route into Estes Park is the **Peak-to-Peak Highway**, a 55-mile byway starting at Central City just off I-70 to the south and running north along Routes 119, 72 and 7. This drive will lead you to high country lakes, through small mountain towns and across the continental divide. You've reached an altitude of 7,500 feet in Estes Park. This high mountain valley is the gateway to the **Rocky Mountain National Park**. Granite summits tower over broad green landscapes, and a few roads inside the park beckon adventuresome drivers. **Old Fall River Road** is a dramatic 11-mile uphill journey with towering cliffs, waterfalls and glacial deposits. **Bear Lake Road** gets you to Bear Lake and some of the most dramatic views and best hiking points. The elevation here is 9,500 feet, but the road remains accessible all year. Cross country skiers and snowshoers take note.

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## Driving Directions

### From Denver International Airport 77 miles (2 hours)

Head north and take the ramp onto Pena Blvd  
Take exit 6B toward Boulder/Ft Collins  
Merge onto E-470 N  
Continue onto Northwest Pkwy  
Take ramp onto US-36 W, continue on US-36 W for 24.1 miles  
Turn left at CO-66 W / CO-7 W / US-36 W / Ute Hwy  
Turn left at Main St  
Take the 2nd right onto CO-66 W / US-36 W / W Main St  
Turn left at Big Thompson Ave / E Elkhorn Ave  
Turn left at E Riverside  
Continue 1.2 miles, turn right into WorldMark Estes Park  
Check-in office is immediately to your left  
Follow above directions to Elkhorn Avenue, turning left onto Moraine  
Once on Moraine, get into the left lane  
Go through the first stop sign  
At second stop sign turn right on Riverside Drive and continue for 1/2 mile  
Turn right into WorldMark Estes Park  
Check-in office is immediately to your left

### **If the main entrance is closed due to weather conditions**

Follow above directions to Elkhorn Avenue  
Turn left at E Riverside  
Continue 1.2 miles, turn right into WorldMark Estes Park  
Check in office is immediately to your left
