Dear All Saints' Parishioners,

I'm delighted that All Saints' Church is your spiritual home. We are blessed by your presence at worship, your involvement in parish ministries, and your continued faithfulness in our shared journey with Christ and with one another.

During this Month of October, we will embark on our annual giving campaign. You will hear from me and fellow parishioners about how the practice of giving is essential to following the Way of Jesus. During this time we will encourage one another to grow in our awareness of the many gifts God has given us, including the gift of our Savior and the gift of this faith community.

Discerning what we give back to God out of all that God has blessed us with is essential in going further along in our journey of faith. God loves us where we are, but does not want us to stay put on the path! This year, I invite you to consider moving one or two percent closer to the tithe.
