PROGRAMS

PRACTICES

Twice a week, Prestonwood Polo Club hosts member practices in the arena or the field weather depending.

Players may request the amount of chukkers they wish to play. Prestonwood Polo Club staff will assign chukkers depending on players' skill levels.

PRO AM LEAGUE

Every Saturday afternoon in the spring and fall (weather depending) members are encouraged to join in the 0-6 Goal Pro Am league. All games will be played in front of the crowd on Field 1. Prestonwood staff will organize the teams and assign pros to patron pairs.

DFW POLO ASSN

In the spring, the DFW Polo Assn will host a 4 Goal tournament played on Fridays and Sundays. In the fall, the DFW Polo Assn will host 6 Goal and 12 Goal leagues. The 6 Goal will be played on Thursdays and Saturdays. The 12 Goal will be played on Fridays and Sundays. To play, contact a Prestonwood staff member.

STABLE RULES

- Helmets Required at all times when riding
- Waiver Required
- No drugs/smoking/foul language allowed
- Fields 1, 2, and 3 are closed unless given permission by Prestonwood staff
- Barn and paddock areas should be kept clean and put all trash in the proper containers
- All tack and gear is put away orderly after use
- Tack and gear is not borrowed from others without permission
- Owners must muck stalls when horses are brought in outside of Prestonwood events
- No food (horse or human) is permitted in locker rooms or tack rooms
- Notify the polo office of problems or repairs as soon as possible
- Please turn off any lights when not in use
- Park all trailers and other vehicles in designated areas
