Signs vs. Symbols

Signs and symbols: both communicate; but signs merely indicate, whereas symbols ask you to participate.

> Signs direct you to something else; symbols draw you into themselves.

Signs illumine the intellect; symbols fertilize the imagination.

Signs aid comprehension; symbols aim at commitment.

Signs speak to consciousness; symbols stir up the subconscious.

Signs strive for clarity; symbols conceal as well as reveal.

Signs will enlighten; symbols can heal.

Signs articulate; symbols integrate. Signs inform; symbols transform.

You read a sign, but inhabit a symbol.

So, when you make the *Sign* of the Cross, remember: it is a *symbol*.
