



41st Annual 4-H Quebec Provincial Rally



From July 21st to 24th, Shawville 4-H welcomed almost 100 members from across the province for the 41st Annual 4-H Quebec Provincial Rally with the theme of Hollywood. During the weekend 4-H'ers had fun showing off their judging skills, animals, handicrafts and public speaking abilities. On Thursday evening, once the animals were settled into the barn, participants and chaperones gathered together for the opening ceremonies followed by the Farmer's Olympics, where the 4-H'ers were mixed by clubs and ages for some friendly competition. Friday morning, the life skills participants completed the compulsory on-site life-skill which was building a trophy out of vegetables. Following the life skills event, was the Public Speaking competition, where 8 members spoke passionately about their topics. Friday afternoon, the 4-H'ers were once again mixed up by clubs and ages for the judging competition. The participants judged yearling beef heifers, meat goats, rabbits, trophies, braids and farm outfits. They also showed off their identification skills by identifying movie animals by their picture and movies by their soundtrack during the mystery class. Friday evening the crowd was overwhelmed by the members' creativity during the costume class. Friday finished off with the fitting competition, in which teams of three fit dairy, beef or sheep. Members rose early Saturday morning to prepare for the show. Projects included sheep, goat, rabbit, poultry, beef and dairy. The event finished off with the banquet Saturday night, where participants and clubs received the awards for the events throughout the weekend. The awards banquet was followed by a barn dance where members were encouraged to bring their instruments and dancing shoes.
