BDCA RESIDENTS: \$100/day + (\$30 setup night before) + \$90/day cleaning fee
NON-RESIDENTS: \$225/day + (\$30 setup night before) + \$90/day cleaning fee

PACKAGE C (Hourly Rate)

BDCA RESIDENTS: \$10/hour + \$90 cleaning fee
NON-RESIDENTS: \$30/hour + \$90 cleaning fee
