Adult-Youth Doubles Rules

Eligibility:

Youth Bowler must be a current registered USBC member. If not registered, you may register the day of at Plaza Lanes. The Adult Bowler is not required to be a registered USBC member.

Divisions:

Boys: 16 & under / 18 & under

Girls: 16 & under / 18 & under

(Based on youth age as of August 1st, 2025)

Teams will be placed by the Youth Bowlers Gender. The Youth Bowler may choose an Adult Partner of any Gender to bowl with them.

Format

Qualifying Round:

- Each team will bowl a Qualifying Round of 4 games of regular tenpin (scratch) bowling.
- Cuts will be based on the High 4 game Series and the total number of entries in each division (Minimum of 4 will advance).
- Ties for the final advancing Qualifying Round teams will be broken by the high single game series bowled by a team.

Championship Round:

- Scores from the qualifying round will be dropped. All championship round games will be baker games in which the youth bowler will bowl the even number frames.
- Matches will be determined by high 2 game baker series total, Each team will bowl one game on each lane on their pair.
- The higher positioned team from qualifying round will have choice of starting lane.
- All Ties in the championship round will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off in which the adult will bowl the 9th frame and the youth bowler will bowl the 10th frame.

Lane Pattern:

A "Challenge" pattern will be applied and posted at tournament check in.

Cost:

\$110 entry fee, \$60 of each entry will be added to the prize fund that will be paid out via SMART scholarship. 100% of the prize fund will be paid out to prize winner.

\$50 goes towards lineage and expenses.

Brackets:

Adult & Youth Brackets and Jackpots will be available.

Youth Brackets & Jackpots will only be paid out in Smart Scholarships.

General Rules:

Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance (including but not limited to rosin and Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor is not permitted. USBC regulations regarding altering a ball surface will be enforced. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowlers area. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the tournament manager to make necessary on-site changes to interpret and enforce all rules, regulation, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event.

Awards: The top 4 teams from each division will be awarded scholarships
