Executive Session Police Committee Meeting  
May 14, 2024

The committee entered into Executive Session under Section 2(c)(1) of the Open Meetings Act to discuss personnel. A Roll Call was taken:

Judy Hinterlong-Yes

Jake Naggs-Yes

Chief Bergeron was also in attendance.

Pam began the Executive Session with the loss of full-time officer Karl Eccles. Chief Bergeron mentioned that he currently has Robert Brumer in the part-time academy. With Karl leaving soon, he would like to ask for consideration of Robert Brumer, after completion of his part time academy training, make him a full-time officer. He would like consideration of changing his academy to full time academy. The village would pay the cost for this, as he is unsure if the state would reimburse. Chief Bergeron would need to ask the state to waive his full-time officer training and enter a transition course instead. He would submit paperwork to the state for approval and they would let him know when the next class would be at that point. He mentioned that while Robert waited for the transition class, he would be working with Chief Bergeron and Justin Hunt, who has recently been putting in more hours. As it stands now, Robert will not have part time academy completed until January of next year. The committee discussed part time officers, pay scale with surrounding towns and advertising for additional part time officers. Jake mentioned the possibility of advertising on Facebook. Chief Bergeron would like to stay away from Facebook for advertisement. Judy added maybe trying Indeed to advertise for part time officers. Chief Bergeron will look into these options to advertise for help.

There being no further business, Judy Hinterlong motioned to exit Executive Session. Jake Naggs seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.
