Kaye has been described as a colorful individual generating enthusiasm and excitement in her work and having great fun in the process. Kaye has owned three quilt shops, designed many collections of fabric for *Wilmington Prints* and currently has new lines twice a year. She has written 15 books, designed many patterns, and block of the month programs for quilt shops. She also has embroidery collections on many of her fabric lines. She has taught in all 50 states, and many countries, sharing her unique style of teaching, enthusiasm and sense of humor. Even though Kaye has semi-retired, she continues to travel and still makes numerous quilts.

LECTURE: WHO WAS ODETTE?

Kaye will give us the story of Odette Ueltschi, former president of BERNINA International, highlighting her pioneering leadership from 1979 to 1988. Under Odette's guidance, BERNINA introduced groundbreaking innovations such as the knee-activated presser foot lifter and stretch stitches. Hailing from Switzerland, She is the daughter and granddaughter of two entrepreneurs, Karl Friedrich Gegauf, a technical genius and father Fritz. It is said of her that, "Everything she did was with her customers in mind. Her sense of the aesthetic and her quality consciousness were a major influence on the style of Bernina. Kaye's decision-making was influenced to a large degree by spontaneity and emotion. The human touch." Her new book features a specially designed quilt block for Odette.

CLASS: THE KAWANDI CLASS (Half Day)

A kawandi quilt is a hand-stitched patchwork quilt made by the Siddis, descendants of African immigrants and brought to India by the Portuguese, French, English, Dutch, and Americans. The kawandi quilt is made from pieces of old and worn-out clothing collected from family members and friends. Bring your scrap pieces and a fat quarter for backing. Kaye will provide assorted 8wt thread and proper needles for \$6. Come ready to learn a new technique and how to make a great personalized gift to give to a loved one!

CLASS: SCRAP MANIA (1 Full Day)

This class will teach you how to use up all the scraps you have lying around. It is 45 simple pieced blocks using an assortment of 2 1/2" strips and 5-10" squares, as well as using rulers that cut half square and quarter square elements.
