The application, proof of college acceptance and recommendation letters can be submitted online, emailed or mailed; however official transcripts must be mailed or uploaded directly from your high school counselor or registrar to be considered. Selected applicants will be required to participate in an interview with the Scholarship Committee. The in-person interview is the final required phase of the application process.
