Holy Scripture

EPISTLE READING - Hebrews 11.1-16

Now Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Indeed, by Faith our ancestors received approval. By Faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the Word of God, so that what is seen was made from things that are not visible. By Faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain's. Through this he received approval as righteous, God Himself giving approval to his gifts; he died, but through his Faith he still speaks. By Faith Enoch was taken so that he did not experience death and "he was not found, because God had taken him" for it was attested before he was taken away that "he had pleased God" and without Faith it is impossible to please God, for whoever would approach Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him. By Faith Noah, warned by God about events as yet unseen, respected the warning and built an ark to save his household; by this he condemned the world and became an heir to the righteousness that is in accordance with Faith. By Faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to set out for a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; and he set out, not knowing where he was going. By Faith he stayed for a time in the land he had been promised, as in a foreign land, living in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise, for he looked forward to the city that has foundations, whose architect and builder is God. By Faith he received power of procreation, even though he was too old—and Sarah herself was barren—because He considered him Faithful who had promised; therefore from one person, and this one as good as dead, descendants were born, "as many as

the stars of Heaven and as the innumerable grains of sand by the seashore." All of these died in Faith without having received the promises, but from a distance they saw and greeted them. They confessed that they were strangers and foreigners on the Earth, for people who speak in this way make it clear that they are seeking a homeland. If they had been thinking of the land that they had left behind, they would have had opportunity to return. But as it is, they desire a better country, that is, a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; indeed, He has prepared a city for them.

a warrior is not delivered by his great strength.*

The war horse is a vain hope for victory,
and by its great might it cannot save.

*Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him,

Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and shield.

Yea, our heart is glad in Him,
because we trust in His holy Name.

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 12.32-40

“Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the Kingdom. Sell your possessions, and give alms; provide yourselves with purses that do not grow old, with a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. “Let your loins be girded and your lamps burning, and be like men who are waiting for their master to come home from the marriage feast, so that they may open to Him at once when He comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when He comes; truly, I say to you, He will gird Himself and have them sit at table, and He will come and serve them. If He comes in the second watch, or in the third, and finds them so, blessed are those servants! But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the thief was coming, he would have been awake and would not have left his house to be broken into. You also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.”
