The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-2-1) prohibits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City during the winter season between the hours of **2:00 AM & 6:00 AM.**

SNOW / SLUSH and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.
