## Four Priorities (Strategies) that will help us achieve our Objective

1. Groups exist to share the Gospel with the Lost
2. Groups exist to develop Biblical Community
3. Groups exist to help believers Grow Spiritually
4. Groups exist to help believers Live Missionally

## Spiritually Speaking, people need...



Let's Talk About Sheep! Two things that people under your Leadership need from you.

- **Hope** - Sheep need to know that their shepherd knows where the green grass is. How can someone follow you if you don't know where you are leading them? People need to know that there is something better out there that they would want to be a part of.
- **Trust** - Sheep need to trust their shepherd that he would not lead them into danger. How can someone follow you if you are not faithful, dependable and trustworthy? People need to know that they can trust you: that you care more for them than you do for yourself.

### How Engaged Are Your People?

- ❖ How Connected are they?
- ❖ Do they feel they are an Important part of the life and ministry of the church?
- ❖ Do they feel that they personally Benefited from being an active part of your church?
- ❖ Do they sense a Personal call or commitment to accomplish the mission/purpose of the church?
