## GENERAL RULES OF ENTRY

1. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance.
2. All trophies to be held for one year only and to be returned CLEAN 21 days before the 2027 show.
3. Cars requiring to park in the wagon park will be charged £15, car park £10
4. All entries to be taken online [www.hambletonshow.com](http://www.hambletonshow.com). Entries close 11th May 2026, from 12th May entries will be 50% extra. No entries to be accepted after 16th May. No postal entries or entries taken on the day
5. If the show re-schedules its show date (usually due to adverse weather conditions) the entry fee will be refunded less an administration cost of 25%, the secretary must have a request of refund BEFORE the new show date, under no circumstances will a refund be given after the new show date. If the show is completely abandoned, refunds will only be given upon receipt of an SAE addressed to the secretary, the entry fee will be refunded less an administration cost of 25%. SAE must be received within 28 days of the cancellation.
6. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
7. Entry fee WILL NOT be refunded if the horses, owners or riders are not correctly registered with the relevant societies before the show day, or if the incorrect class is entered online.
8. All prize money, prizes and cups to be collected on the show days, nothing to be sent out after the show days.
9. **CHAMPION OR RESERVE CHAMPION PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE GIVEN OUT UNTIL AFTER THE SUPREMES. To be collected from secretary's tent on the day of the show.**
10. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes.
12. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for accidents or damage to riders, competitors, spectators, owners or animals or any other property.
13. The decision of the judge is final.
14. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not. Please see BSPS Rule 43 regarding all BPS classes
15. Any objection or protest must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by a fee of £50 which may be forfeited to the show funds in the event of an objection been overruled
16. **No litter is to be left on the showground. CLEANING OUT OF HORSEBOXES AND TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**
17. No nomination or substitute entries will be accepted at any time.
18. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
19. **All grooms entering the ring must be correctly dressed and must wear a hat in the ring.**
20. Entry fees will only be returned (minus 25%) with a valid vet's or doctor's certificate BEFORE 20th May 2026
21. Prize money: For all ridden and In-hand classes prize money will be awarded as follows. Three entries or less 1st prize only, four or five entries 1st and 2nd Prize and 6 or more entries as per schedule.
22. **RULES FOR RIDDEN SPORTS HORSE AFFILIATED CLASSES.** It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes, the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn. No earrings to be worn when competing in the Sports Horse GB affiliated classes, and horses must be shod on all four hooves.
23. All horses and ponies entering the Showground must be vaccinated, and vaccination certificates / passports must accompany the horse or pony to the Show and be available for checking. Un-vaccinated horses, or those exhibitors unable to produce a passport on request will be prevented from competing and will be asked to leave the showground. Entry fees will not be refunded.
24. In the event of inclement weather we politely request that there is no lunging anywhere on the show field.

## **THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND HORSE OR PONY OF THE YEAR**

The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand Championship, NEC, Birmingham, 7th - 11th October 2026. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete, provided it has not already won a qualifying round in 2026:

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2026 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2026 or are ineligible then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round. Foal champions are not eligible.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

There will be no direct entry into Supreme In-hand Championship Qualifier, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

## HUNTER CLASSES

### UNAFFILIATED AND NOVICE RIDDEN HUNTER

Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain require ALL exhibits in classes 2 to 16, 11 & 19 to 34 to be registered with the society. The Hunter classes are run in accordance with the rules of the Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain 2026 Day Ticket = £45 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £45 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for (R.I.H.S), in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes, the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn.

This show is a qualifier for the £2,000 Ridden Challenge jointly sponsored by the IDHS (GB) and Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show. The highest placed Pure Bred and Part Bred (not already qualified) from 2 to 5 will qualify for the final. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive £100, and the highest placed Irish Draught Part Bred will receive £50.

(iii) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm or show a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts showing livery production or training charges, from a person outside the immediate family concerned, in any showing classes, Sport Horse Breeding (GB) or otherwise.

(iv) Act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, Sport Horse Breeding (GB) or otherwise.

(v) A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in ANY class, Sport Horse Breeding (GB) or otherwise, with the exception of Working and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to and including the Royal International Horse Show.

16 (The above Rule, 3e(v), does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Showing Professional, during the previous season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership).

(vi) If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/Council, i.e., if you ride / compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional.

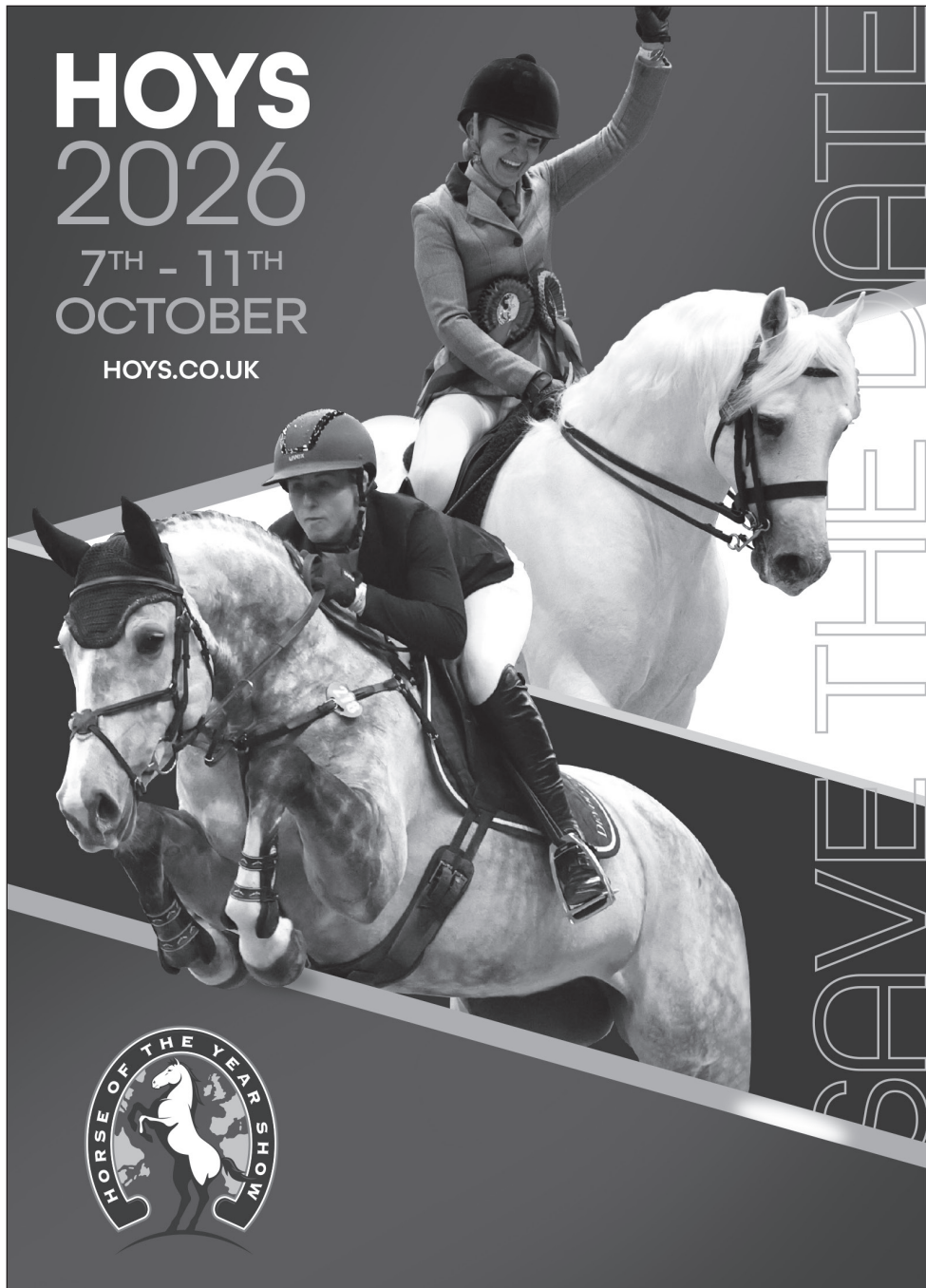

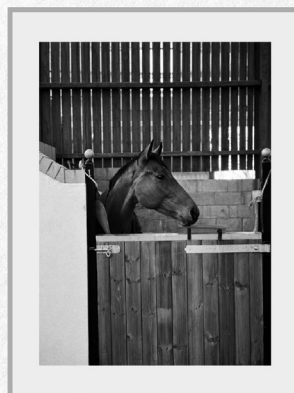

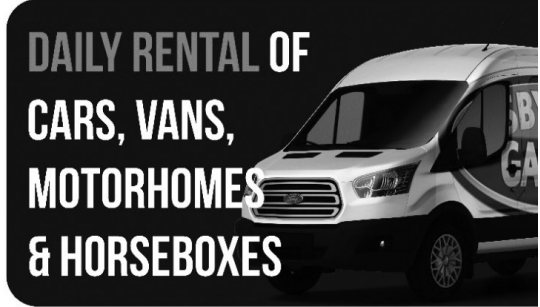
