Junie loves car rides and occasionally plays with a toy or goes outside to enjoy the sun. She is crate trained, but prefers to sleep with her person. Junie loves her person and wants to be with them all the time. She does not like to be alone. Junie needs a home where someone is home more than gone. Mostly, she needs someone to love her and provide the special care she needs. Junie will reward that person with a lifetime of love and companionship.
