

**Town of Stratton
Selectmen's Meeting
April 12, 2021**

Present: Selectmen: Al Dupell - Chair, Larry Bills, Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Kevin Robinson, and Kent Young – Clerk.

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 7:30pm at the Stratton Town Office. Orders were reviewed and signed.

Modifications to the Agenda: The Clerk asked to add the following items to the Agenda: 1) Consideration of an Access Permit Application; 2) a Sign request for Mountain Rd. and 3) Consideration of Personnel Policy agreements with Elected Officials. Larry Bills so moved. Kevin Robinson seconded – all concurred.

Road Crew Issues: Yearly Bids: The Clerk stated that the bid requests have been sent out and published in the Brattleboro Reformer for consideration at the May 10 meeting, with exception of CaCl, as we have an existing contract for its supply. Chris Liller stated that he does not know when he will get confirmation of a Paving Grant, but the bids reflect that an award is contingent on receipt of a Grant. **Sand and Salt:** The Chair asked the Foreman if he had reviewed the existence of a budget surplus for the year to date, and if one exists, to put it toward stocking up on sand and salt. The Foreman will discuss the budget with the Treasurer. **FLEET permits:** The Selectmen reviewed overweight permit applications from Cota and Cota Inc. and G.W. Tatro Construction, Inc.. Chris Liller moved to approve said permits. Kevin Robinson seconded – all concurred and the Chair signed the permits. **Access Permit Application:** Chris Liller presented said application submitted by Francis Spinella on West Jamaica Rd.. He stated that the location is acceptable to him and that a culvert will need to be installed at that location. The Access is apparently currently marked and he will also measure to it for the creation of an E911 number for the site. Following the discussion, all Selectmen signed to approve the application. **Mountain Road Signage:** The Selectmen reviewed a request that caution signage be installed prior to the Forrester Rd. intersection. The Foreman agreed to look into it, but that a sign may already be designated for that location through the STP HRRR program signage agreement with the State, which should be implemented soon, as the agreement was finalized in 2018.

Personnel Policy: The Selectmen reviewed and all signed agreements with regularly-employed Town Office personnel, elected to their positions who have agreed to the applicable terms of Stratton's Personnel Policy.

Minutes: Greg Marcucci moved to approve the Selectmen's Minutes of March 22, 2021. Kevin Robinson seconded. All concurred and the minutes were approved.

Adjourn: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:45p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
