Clinical Research is a scientific study that involves human participants to investigate diseases, treatments, and health interventions. It aims to improve human health and well being by:

- Understanding disease mechanisms: Studying how diseases develop and progress to identify potential targets for treatment.
- Testing new treatments: Evaluating the safety, effecacy, and tolerability of experimental drugs, therapies, or devices.
- Improving existing treatments: Comparing different treatment options to find the most effective and safe ones.
- Developing preventive mesures: identifying factors that contribute to disease and finding ways to prevent it.
