A total of 16 teams competed this year in 4 divisions.

Class B (65-69) was won by the team of Al Amodeo and Bob Evans. They shot 1502 scratch and 1601 with handicap.

Class C (60-64) was won by Dennis LaFontaine and Al Barcomb with a score of 1484 scratch and 1535 handicap.

Class D (55-59) was won by Paul Greene and Barry Brockway. They shot 1423 scratch and 1531 handicap.

And in Class E (50-54) Ernie Brennan and Dan Billington took the top spot with a scratch score of 1241, 1451 handicap.

The event was highlighted by plenty of excellent scores including a 300 game and a 795 series by Barry Brockway.

Al Barcomb and Dennis LaFontaine put up some big numbers. Al excelled with games of 245, 247, and 279 for a 771 series. His partner, Dennis fired games of 227, 266, and 220 for a 713 set.
