ST. DOMINIC SCHOOL STUDENT SERVICE **REQUIREMENTS**

As stated in the School-wide Learning Expectations, as responsible citizens, students of St. Dominic School are to show a commitment to volunteerism and public service. Students are encouraged to go beyond the required service number of service hours and choose activities that are meaningful to them.

Service Hour Requirements:

All students must fulfill the required number of service hours for the year without exception. COMPLETED SERVICE HOUR SHEETS WILL BE DUE IN MAY (specific date to be determined by your homeroom teacher). Failure to complete the required number of service hours by the assigned due date will jeopardize a student's participation in field trips, class privileges, and graduation activities.

Service will be divided into three categories:

- Service to the School
- Service to the Parish
- Service to the Community

6th Grade: Must complete a total of 6 hours of service, with 2 hours in each

category. (The Service to the School requirement will be met through

each student's rotation as a "greeter" in the mornings before school begins.)

7th Grade: Must complete a total of 12 hours of service, with 4 hours in each category.

> (The Service to the School requirement will be met through each student's participation in recycling collection and unstacking of the Parish Hall chairs. One hour of the Service to the Parish requirement will be fulfilled by each student's rotation in shelving food for St. Vincent de Paul. These

activities will be done during school hours.)

8th Grade: Must complete a total of 15 hours of service, with 5 hours in each

> category. (The Service to the School requirement will be met through each student's monthly rotation as a Hot Lunch Helper, which will be

completed during school hours.)

Members of CJSF: (California Junior Scholarship The CJSF motto is "Scholarship for Service" and its purpose is to foster high standards of scholarship, service, and citizenship on the part of California students in grades seven and eight while promoting

Federation) appropriate activities among its members. CJSF qualifying members are required to complete 1 additional service hour for each trimester they

qualify for membership. These additional hours may be in any

category.

Possible Service Hour Activities:

Service hours are not limited to these suggested events. Any service activity that is NOT school or parish sponsored needs to have prior approval by the principal or homeroom teacher. Students must not receive any type of compensation for their service and may not complete service for family members or relatives.
