The ensemble production is directed by Sonia Schonning, with music direction by Kevin Quill, and choreography by Elena Novero and Meg Morris. NOCE *OF AGES* features a cast of well known Cape Cod talent, including Wil Moser, Hope O' Connor, Tala Schonning, Sara Bleything, Beau Jackett, Rebecca Riley, Zane Euerle Bender, Rob Grady, Zack Johnson, Sean MacIsaac, Max Dexter, Morgan Dexter, Kevin Kenneally, Rachael Kenneally, Rob Minshall, Meg Morris, Kayla Piggot, and Abi Wilfong. Band members include Kevin Quill as conductor and keyboard 1, Rick Schonning on Keyboard 2, Shane Fitzgerald on guitar, Jim Sanborn, Jr. on bass, and Brent Alger on drums.

Kansas with stars in her eyes. But the rock and roll fairy-tale is about to end when German developers sweep into town with plans to turn the fabled Strip into just another capitalist strip mall.
