(Refrain)

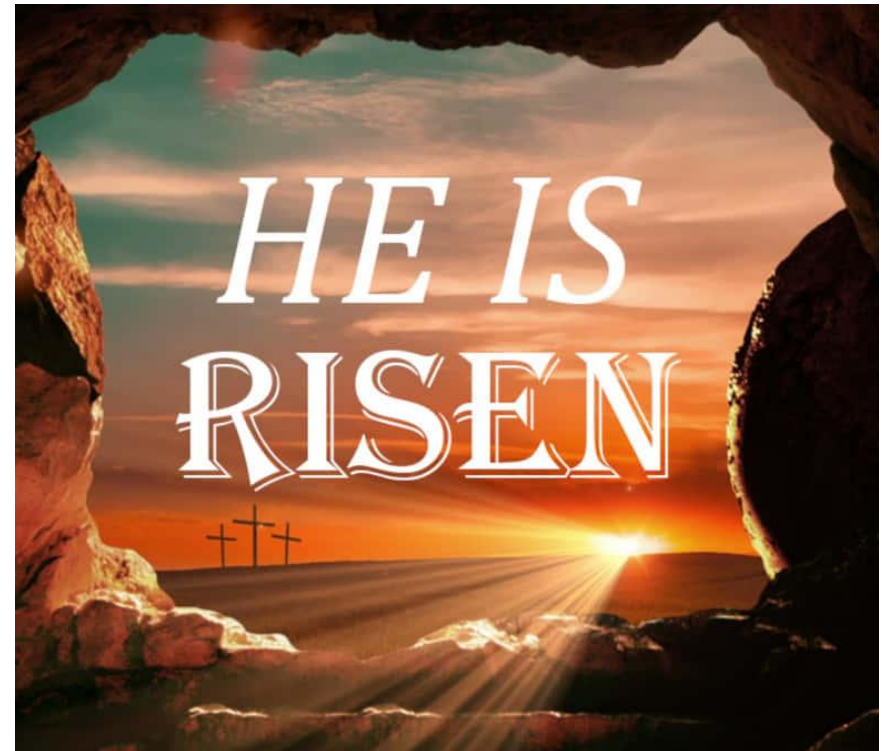
Rejoice, rejoice, O Christian, lift up your voice and sing
