Re-Opening of WWCDTC Building Update

From WWCDTC Board

To keep everyone safe:

All People who are entering the facility are asked to wear a mask or a face covering at this time. If you are running a dog you may take off your mask but when leaving the course you are requested to cover back up.

Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms you should not enter the building until 3 days have passed without symptoms. These symptoms include: fever, dry cough, and difficulty catching your breath, chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache or sore throat.

If you are in contact with a COVID 19 patient you may not enter the building until your quarantine has been completed.

Social distancing requirements must be followed at all times.

Frequently and before leaving the building all high touch surfaces such as door handles and bathrooms will need to be wiped down with sanitizer.

You must bring your own chairs to use, no use of club chairs at this time

When bringing in multiple dogs, bring them in one at a time. No crates will be allowed to be left overnight in the building.

Weather permitting your class can be held outside. Instructor's choice.

Your Club will be safe as long as members do the necessary cleaning after they have used the building and equipment.

Necessary cleaning is wiping equipment used, door handles, tables, counters, and any other items used.

The Club will have available hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, paper towels, etc. The Club will have the cleaning equipment in the box on top of the crates in front of the building and ask that it is returned after use. We will be using the disinfectant Odr-Ban.
