

# Quilt Block of the quarter template

Title: Jan – Mar 2018 Elongated Star block

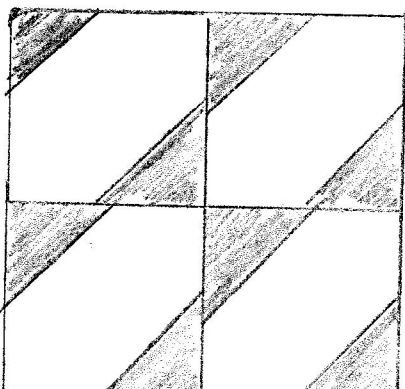
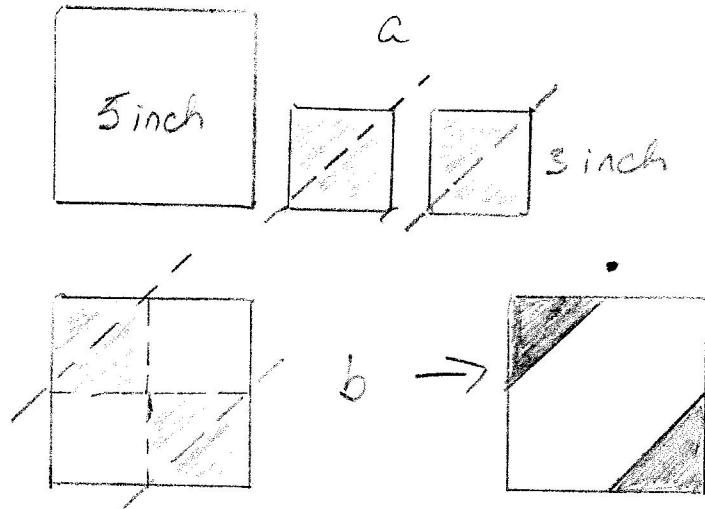
This quarter we will be using 6 inch blue squares (cut into 3 inch squares) and 5 in white or white on white squares. This block can be scrappy or not- it's up to you. The basic unit is the 5 inch white square with 2- 3 inch squares sewn on the diagonal on opposite corners. You will need 4 of these units for each block.

Directions:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 3 inch squares. (a) Place the 3 inch squares on 2 opposite corners of the 5 inch squares (b) and sew on the line. Trim and press towards the color. This square should still measure 5 inches. Make 4.

When you put the 4 units together as shown (c) the elongated stars appear. The block should measure 9.5 inches square.

Don't forget to put your name on each block you turn in- it's your ticket for the drawing.



Block should be 9½ inches square.
