**PARENTS/DRIVERS: CAW WILL NOT CHECK IN CAMPERS BEFORE 7:00 pm. IF YOU ARRIVE EARLY, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO STAY WITH YOUR CAMPER(S) UNTIL CHECK-IN BEGINS AND THEY ARE COMPLETELY CHECKED IN WITH CAW STAFF**

## Section 2: How to Register & Pay

**CAW USES AN ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM FOR ALL PROGRAMS. PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REGISTERING THEIR CAMPERS ONLINE. FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, EACH CAMPER MUST BE FULLY REGISTERED ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31 (2 WEEKS BEFORE CAMP) OR THEY MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND CAMP. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS TO DO SO, PLEASE CALL OUR OFFICE AND WE WILL REGISTER YOUR CAMPER(S) OVER THE PHONE.**

- Navigate to the "Programs & Events" page on our website at [www.camparrahwanna.org](http://www.camparrahwanna.org) and click "Register Here"  
If you do not have internet access, please call our office ASAP and we will register your camper over the phone
- If this is your first time using the online system**, select the green "Register" option and create an account with your (parent/guardian) information. Once your information is complete, the system will prompt you to register a camper for a program
- If you have already created an account** for a previous program, select the gray "Login" button. After entering your email and password, you will then be able to ADD A NEW PROGRAM TO EXISTING CAMPERS, or add new campers.
- HELPFUL HINT: the system is designed to automatically take you to any page that is missing information - which may not be the page you want. When in doubt, find your name in the top LEFT corner and select "Dashboard".
- In order to ensure that our excellent program is in place and volunteers are ready for your campers, **REGISTRATION WILL BE CLOSED AFTER JANUARY 31**. Campers will only be added after that date if extra qualified counselors are available.

Instead... CONNECT WITH YOUR CHURCH representative to find out how much of the fee is your responsibility then PAY YOUR CHURCH directly for your camper's registration fee.

When your camper's online registration is complete, CAW will notify your church. Once they confirm that they "know" your camper, then a "Church VOUCHER" will be added to your account. IT WILL STILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CONNECT WITH YOUR CHURCH AND PAY THEM

## Continued... Section 2: How to Register & Pay

### **OPTION 2: PAY CAMP ARRANNA - BEFORE OR AT CHECK-IN**

If your camper is NOT attending camp through one of the churches listed above, please submit payment by:

1. MAILING A PERSONAL CHECK, BANK CHECK, BILL-PAY CHECK or MONEY ORDER to  
Camp Arran Wannan, Inc | 24075 E Arran Wannan Blvd. | Welches, OR 97067  
Be sure to include **CAMPER'S NAME & CAMP SESSION** on the memo line.

If sending one check for multiple campers, **NOTE THE \$ AMOUNT THAT APPLIES TO EACH CAMPER**

2. PAY AT CHECK-IN

CAW will accept CREDIT CARDS AT CHECK-IN (we still DO NOT accept PAYMENTS ONLINE)

You are also welcome to bring a CASH, CHECK, or MONEY ORDER to check-in

You will receive an email notice once a payment is received and processed to your online account

7. Cancellations made at least (2) two weeks before camp are eligible for a refund of all but a \$50 processing fee

Refunds will NOT be issued for cancellations made less than (2) two weeks prior to session, except in the case of illness or injury

### **DISCOUNTS will be applied during online registration**

- a. EARLY Registration: All campers who are fully registered on or before January 15th will receive the above-stated \$10 discount
- b. SIBLING: \$5 off each camper when 2 or more campers per immediate family sign up for camp
- c. NEW CAMPER: \$10 off if you have never attended a Camp Arran Wannan program before

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

- a. Please contact your local church for scholarship availability first
- b. If you aren't connected with a church, or they are not able to provide a scholarship, don't worry! Just follow these steps:  
CAW believes it is important for each camper/family to contribute SOMETHING towards their camp cost, but we never want people to miss out on this special opportunity because of an inability to pay the full registration fee. Because of that commitment, a partial scholarship will ALWAYS be awarded to any camper who takes the time to complete all 3 of these steps:

1. Request the CAW Scholarship Application Paperwork
2. Complete one form per camper
3. Submit completed form to the CAW office via email, snail-mail, our website, or fax

### ...Continued Section 4: What to Bring & NOT to Bring

#### PLEASE DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS TO CAMP WITH YOU:

1. Non-prescription drugs or drug paraphernalia; alcohol of any kind; tobacco of any kind; marijuana of any kind  
Prescription & OTC medications must be checked in with Medical Personnel at check-in and will be administered as per Dr. and/or Guardian instructions by certified Medical Professional
2. Weapons: firearms, swords, knives, etc.
3. Inappropriate clothing - here are some examples:  
Swimwear: if you have a two-piece bathing suits, you will be asked to wear a t-shirt/tank-top over it; no Speedo's!  
You will be asked to change into something more appropriate if your t-shirt has explicit pictures or words on it  
Shorts, dresses and skirts need to be a modest length (fingers don't touch skin if hanging your arms down to your side)  
Arrah Wanna leaders reserve the right to ask any camper to change their clothes at any time  
Let's dress in a way that is respectful to God, ourselves and each other!

#### ITEMS OF VALUE ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!

Cell phones, tablets, music players, video games, electronics, etc. can have a positive effect on your experience at camp just as easily as a negative one. If these items are used in a way that make others feel excluded, distract you from activities & conversations, and/or disturb group time, the CAW leadership team reserves the right to ask you to put them away for the remainder of camp. If the concern persists, we will request that a parent/guardian come and pick up the item. It is important to be engaged in the program at all times, as our leadership has worked hard to make all parts of our program relevant to all campers. We know electronics are an important way to stay connected to family and friends, but this is a unique opportunity to experience things from a new perspective, and we don't want any camper to miss out on the powerful things happening around them.

**PARENTS: PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF THIS GOAL AND CALL THE CAW OFFICE IF YOU NEED TO CONTACT YOUR CAMPER IF ANY OBJECTS LISTED IN ITEM 1 & 2 ABOVE COME TO CAMP WITH A CAMPER, ARRAH WANNA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEND THAT CAMPER HOME IMMEDIATELY AND REPORT IT TO CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES**

#### Section 5: What do we do at camp?

Spending a weekend at camp is one of the BEST things you will ever do! In the winter we offer activities like snow tubing on Mt. Hood, playing creative and wacky games in the gym and around camp, drinking hot cocoa, and hanging out with our amazing leadership team! Campers spend some time each day worshipping God in song and discussion as a group, as well as more personal cabin Bible study sessions. CAW is a place you are SURE to make life-long friends, learn more about how much you are loved, and have a blast while doing it.

ALL campers will be enjoying Snow Tubing on Saturday, February 16th AT NO ADDITIONAL COST  
Transportation and supervision is provided by CAW staff/volunteers for all activities during the weekend.

#### Section 6: Health Information

CAW takes the health and welfare of our campers very seriously - trained/certified medical personnel and nearby clinics assure that campers are well taken care of while at Camp. We also fall all State & National expectations for health services.

**It is important for you to thoroughly & completely fill in all required information on your camper's online registration form. If there are any changes or additions to your medical information, please make those changes to your online account prior to your arrival at camp.**

#### **MEDICATIONS:**

If specified online that your camper takes prescription or OTC medications, you will automatically receive an email that includes a link to our "Camper Medication Instructions" form and directions on how to prepare the medications before camp

**IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FILL OUT THE "CAMPER MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS" FORM AND SUBMIT IT TO CAW BEFORE OR AT CHECK-IN. ALL MEDICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE MEDICAL STAFF AT CHECK-IN AND WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO CAMPERS ACCORDING TO THEIR COMPLETED "CAMPER MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS" SHEET.**

Please note that CAW may require a copy of the original prescription and/or container. Your insurance is primary. Unless prescribed by a doctor, please do not send fluoride with your camper, as it creates more work for the medical staff than necessary

#### Section 7: Letters

Mail-call is one of the best parts of the day for a camper who actually gets mail, so we encourage you to send your camper a letter or care package! To ensure it gets here in time, please send it no later than (4) business days before the last day of camp. Letters can be sent to:
