

Driving Instructions

We realize that driving on St. Thomas can be a bit challenging as our road signs are not too good. The GPS often will get you lost as well, so here are the driving direction from the three main areas that you might be driving from:

Coming from downtown (Charlotte Amalie):

Coming from Havensight (Cruise Ship dock):

Coming from downtown drive west through town past the fort and turn left after the parking lot at the traffic signal.

Coming from Havensight (cruise ship dock), head west and turn right at the traffic signal just after the Federal Building and police station.

Drive North. You will come to another traffic signal. Continue along this road several blocks up to the stop sign. Turn left at the stop sign and start to climb up the hill (Rt. 35) Stay on this main road and after the sharp switch-back make a left turn at the next main intersection. There will be a sign for the Mafolie Hotel and Restaurant and several other signs posted at this intersection (Rt. 33). Pass the hotel and follow the road up to the next main intersection. Turn right here and continue up the hill. Bear to your right at the split in the road (Rt. 37) and pass the parking lot for Sibilly School and turn left at the intersection with the tree in the circle in the middle of the road by the Catholic Church (Our Lady of Perpetual Help) (Rt. 40). Pass the church and five houses on your left side and you will see a sign for an intersection. Turn left here. There is a blue sign that reads "Joseph Sibilly Circle" This is Rt. 334 also known as Bishop Drive. This is a one-way road going up the hill. Continue up this road and you will see our sign on your right just before the stop sign. Our parking lot is on your right just after the sign.

Coming from the East End: (Magens Bay, Red Hook, Skyline Drive)

Drive west along Skyline Drive (Rt. 40) or up from Magens Bay Road (Rt. 35) until the road ends. Turn right and continue past Drake's Seat overlook up to the next main intersection (Rt. 37) and turn left. There will be two stone columns on your right side that read "Papaya Hill". Continue a couple of hundred feet further and turn right at the intersection with the tree in the circle in the middle of the road by the Catholic Church (Our Lady of Perpetual Help) (Rt. 40). Pass the church and five houses on your left side and you will see a sign for an intersection. Turn left here. There is a blue sign that reads "Joseph Sibilly Circle" This is Rt. 334 also known as Bishop Drive. This is a one-way road going up the hill. Continue up this road and you will see our sign on your right just before the stop sign. Our parking lot is on your right just after the sign.

Coming from the West:

Come up the mountain from Crown Mountain Rd. (Rt. 33) or Scott Free Road (Rt. 405) or Hull Bay Road (Rt. 37 then onto Rt. 404) and arrive at the intersection called "Four Corners" which is a four-way stop intersection. Drive as if you were going to visit Mountain Top (Rt 33). This is the road that heads up the hill. At the intersection for Mountain Top you will see a yard in front of you with the Eiffel Tower and some birds (Yes, a French man lives there!) Bear to your right here and you will see that there is a stepped water feature in pink blocks in his front yard. You will continue driving East on this road and as the road starts downhill you will eventually start to see a long pink split-faced concrete block wall on your left. This wall ends at an intersection where you will be facing into a one-way road with "Do Not Enter" signs facing towards you. We are located just 30-40 feet down this one way road on your left side. So just make sure that there is no traffic coming up the road and you can drive down and park in our parking lot on your left side.
