



Amanda Kidd did her growing up in Giles County before moving off to the big city of Nashville. After getting her first failing grade on a literature test in Mrs. White's English class at Richland High School, she never hoped to have anything to do with English literature again. The siren song of books never stopped calling, though.

A reader all her life, Amanda finally decided to try her hand at writing. She published a blog titled "Love, Jimmie" and wrote faithfully for eight years. The blog world fell apart, as did her dedication to it, and the only writing she did was for personal consumption or for her annual Christmas letter sent to friends and family. Those letters have some notoriety now as they detail her

experiences with trying on Spanx for the first time or her deep-felt emotions about being middle aged.

During 2020 Amanda and her neighbor, Jamie McKean Hodges, began writing a series of essays for each other. These essays were meant to honor the Lord in their own lives but eventually turned into a missive they wanted to share with the world. Or at least their friends and family. "Prayers from the Front Porch" is that missive.
